May 13 - June 29 1998 - **Paris, Grand Palais** *Le Temps des rois maudits*.

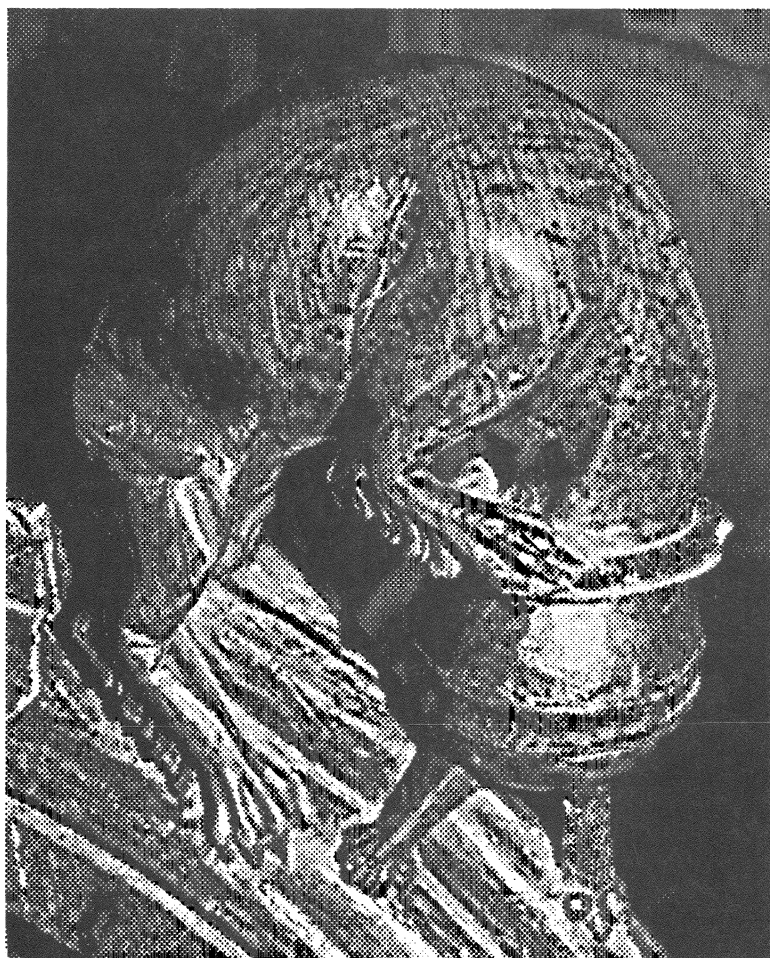
Summer, 1998 Antwerp: Paintings of Pieter II and Jan I Bruegel.
